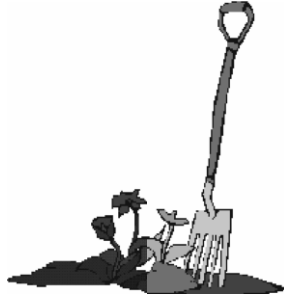

<b>Compost</b>		
Prairiewood Fines	\$38	composted mixed yard debris
Garden Compost	\$40	Prairiewood fines and horse manure
Horse Manure Compost	\$42	composted horse manure and bedding
<b>Topsoil</b>		
Planter's Soil	\$48	topsoil and horse manure compost
Blended Topsoil	\$45	pulverized soil and compost
<b>Mulch</b>		
Garden Mulch	\$25	composted leaves, straw, and wood shavings
Natural Brown AA	\$28	medium-texture general purpose mulch
Prairiewood Mulch	\$32	rich, dark, composted wood mulch

<b><u>Product</u></b>	<b><u>Recommended Uses</u></b>	<b><u>Benefits</u></b>
<b>Compost</b>		
<b>Prairiewood Fines</b>	Soil amendment (1"-2") for existing flower beds. To make new beds over existing lawn, spread (4'-6") in Fall and overwinter to kill grass, then till in Spring	Excellent for loosening heavy clay soils, or building soil in existing beds
<b>Garden Compost</b>	Soil amendment (1"-2") tilled into soil in Spring; topdressing (½"-2") for lawns or raised beds; potting soil mix (25%-30%)	High in humus, beneficial soil organisms, rejuvenates existing soil
<b>Horse Manure Compost</b>	Soil amendment for vegetable gardens (1"-2") and till into soil	Great for vegetable gardens, contains more nutrients than leaf based compost
<b>Topsoil</b>		
<b>Planter's Soil</b>	Raised bed gardens (up to 8")	Vigorous plant growth, drains well
<b>Blended Topsoil</b>	New lawns and gardens (up to 6")	Stays loose, plants root quickly and deep, holds moisture and nutrients
<b>Mulch</b>		
<b>Garden Mulch</b>	Vegetable and flower gardens (2"-3") apply to surface as needed	Ideal for soil building, breaks down to form soil within 1 season
<b>Natural Brown AA</b>	Trees and shrubs (3"-4")	Weed barrier, moisture holding; semi-annual applications are normal; fades to natural gray
<b>Prairiewood Mulch</b>	Flower beds and new plantings of trees or shrubs (2"-4"); for mulch build up problem on existing beds (2"-4")	Builds soil rapidly; breaks down within 1 season; stays dark brown naturally
