Product	Recommended Uses	Benefits		
Compost				
Prairiewood Fines	Soil amendment (1"-2") for existing flower beds. To make new beds over existing lawn, spread (4'-6") in Fall and overwinter to kill grass, then till in Spring	Excellent for loosening heavy clay soils, or building soil in existing beds		
Garden Compost	Soil amendment (1"-2") tilled into soil in Spring; topdressing (½"-2") for lawns or raised beds; potting soil mix (25%-30%)	High in humus, beneficial soil organisms, rejuvenates existing soil		
Horse Manure Compost	Soil amendment for vegetable gardens (1"-2") and till into soil	Great for vegetable gardens, contains more nutrients than leaf based compost

Planter's Soil	Raised bed gardens (up to 8")	Vigorous plant growth, drains well		
Blended Topsoil	New lawns and gardens (up to 6")	Stays loose, plants root quickly and deep, holds moisture and nutrients		
Mulch				
Garden Mulch	Vegetable and flower gardens (2"-3") apply to surface as needed	Ideal for soil building, breaks down to form soil within 1 season		
Natural Brown AA	Trees and shrubs (3"-4")	Weed barrier, moisture holding; semi-annual applications are normal; fades to natural gray		
Prairiewood Mulch	Flower beds and new plantings of trees or shrubs (2"-4"); for mulch build up problem on existing beds (2"-4")	Builds soil rapidly; breaks down within 1 season; stays dark brown naturally
